

Dorothea Quarry Dive Site



WARNING

This dive site is a disused slate quarry in North Wales. The Landowner does not promote scuba diving, but the site is used regularly by divers. The danger here is that the water is over 100m deep and can be as cold as 5°C even in the summer. Access is via rough dirt tracks and steep ground giving rise to very strenuous walks. **Emergency support is not readily available.**

ProScuba do not promote any diver training here. For qualified divers with the correct training and experience this can be an ideal venue, but at their own risk.



Meeting and notes:

We normally meet at Bangor Tesco for breakfast. From here it takes about 30mins to get to the dive site. Once we get to the site there are no facilities or toilets (plenty of bushes). You will need to bring Air for your dives, food and drinks. This site is quite exposed and open to the weather.
